Community Threat Assessment and Support Protocol

Prairie Spirit School Division is a proud signed partner in the Saskatoon and Area Community Threat Assessment and Support Protocol (CTASP) which was launched in 2011.

This protocol allows community partners to proactively share information, advice and expertise to provide appropriate trauma-informed support to our students and families. Each of our schools has a dedicated team who work within this protocol, including principals/vice principals, counsellors and other school leaders. All high-risk behaviours and threats will be taken seriously, investigated, and responded to appropriately.

Our shared understanding and commitment is to safely equip staff to effectively intervene and respond when a student is in crisis.

The Community Threat Assessment and Support Protocol is an important part of our school division's caring, healthy and safe schools strategy.
